## OAISD SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS AND STAFF RECOGNIZED BY STATE ORGANIZATIONS

**Holland, MI-** Two OAISD school board members received recognition from the Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB) for classes completed in MASB's leadership training program, as well as for conference attendance, years of service and leadership activities.

OAISD School Board President Eric Packer of Allendale received the President's Award of Recognition; MASB's highest individual honor, for completing all seven levels of MASB courses; a total of 29 advanced classes and minimum of 1,383 education credits. Packer has served on the OAISD Board of Education for 11 years and will be honored at MASB's Annual Leadership Conference in November in Detroit.

OAISD School Board Trustee and 12-year board member Carol Slagh of Zeeland received the Master Diamond Award for completing four levels of MASB courses; a total of 14 advanced classes and minimum of 528 education credits.

School board members from across Michigan earned awards from the Michigan Association of School Boards for their efforts to improve their leadership skills and become more effective school leaders, demonstrating their commitment to student achievement and their own continuous improvement.

"We are fortunate to have Board members eager to build new skills in an effort to serve our district," OAISD Superintendent Pete Haines said. "These awards note milestones for two very dedicated leaders."
