



# NBA OFFICIATING Last Two Minute Report

Below is the league's assessment of officiated events that occurred in the last two minutes of last night's games which were within five points at the two-minute mark (and during overtime, where applicable). The plays assessed include all calls (whistles) and notable non-calls. Notable non-calls will generally be defined as material plays directly related to the outcome of a possession. Calls that are indirectly related to the outcome (e.g., a non-call on contact away from the play) and/or plays that are only observable with the help of a stop-watch, zoom or other technical support, but have some merit in reporting, are noted in brackets along with the explanatory comments. <b>Comment:</b> Richardson (MIA) sets the screen on Lee (CHA) and gives him room to avoid the contact.

<b>Comment:</b> Zeller (CHA) firms up as he sets the screen on Richardson (MIA) and gives him room to avoid the contact.

<b>Comment:</b> [Incidental or immaterial] Whiteside (MIA) sets the screen on Batum (CHA) without giving him room to avoid the contact.

<b>Comment:</b> Lee (CHA) maintains legal guarding position as he defends Wade's (MIA) drive. Wade initiates contact on the play and briefly loses control of the ball.

<b>Comment:</b> Lee (CHA) maintains legal guarding position and makes incidental contact with Wade (MIA) that does not affect his RSBQ.

<b>Comment:</b> Walker (CHA) cleanly blocks Dragic's (MIA) jump shot attempt.						
Q4	00:05.2	Foul: Shooting	Cody Zeller	Dwyane Wade	CNC	<a href="#">Video</a>
<b>Comment:</b> Zeller (CHA) comes towards Wade (MIA) from across the restricted area, planting his foot and jumping vertically to defend Wade's shot. Zeller absorbs contact when it occurs and, while his arms are not completely vertical, multiple angles confirm they do not make contact with Wade. Therefore, Zeller maintains a legal guarding position as he attempts to defend the shot.
