"THE ANALYSIS OF PRESCRIBING IN GENERAL PRACTICE - A GUIDE TO AUDIT & RESEARCH"

"Improving Prescribing", the recent Working Paper on the indicative prescribing scheme, announced the publication of a guide to prescribing audit and research as part of the Government's initiative to promote quality prescribing (para 2.14). This guide is being published today and will be supplied to FPCs for distribution to all general practices. Copies of the guide and "Dear Doctor" letter are attached for your information.

The guide is a reference document for practices undertaking audits of their prescribing based on the information PACT provides. It will also be of interest to FPCs.
