

InSNAPSHOT ALLOWS USERS WITH AN NEC COLOUR DISPLAY TERMINAL TO VIEW LIVE IMAGES AT THE TOUCH OF A BUTTON

This low cost application will display the still image from the chosen image source at the colour display of the NEC IP terminal.

The image source can be any compatible image hosted on a web server for example, CCTV monitor, Door entry, Secure Area camera or web based image file.

Multiple image sources can be viewed, each one assigned to a dedicated programmable function key at the IP terminal. The image sources are defined within the InSnapshot InApp where they are also assigned to the function key image ID. Users can then simply assign the function key image ID to one of their Programmable Function keys; pressing the Function Key will show the image.

SPECIFICATION

- > Image refresh rate from minimum 1 second interval
- > Still image must be supported by the webcam/video doorphone, video streaming is not available
- > DT820/DT920 Display size 320x240 pixel
- > DT830/DT930 Display size 480x272 pixel

Images should be of the suitable size for display at the terminal, larger image will be cropped to fit. Very large images may not display.

The image source (e.g. web camera/Video Doorphone) must be able to create the still image of the correct specification for InSnapshot to display at the IP terminal.

- > InSnapshot requires a system license and each image source requires an image license
- > InSnapshot system license BE118945 SV9100 InSNAPSHOT V1 LIC
- > Image source license BE118946 SV9100 InSNAPSHOT IMG-01 LIC
- > Up to 99 image sources can be defined

InSnapshot is activated when the SV9100 60 day Demo/trial license is enabled, this can be used to verify the compatibility of a desired image source.
