



Public Auction of Water Quality Stewardship Credits

Private dollars have been invested in farm management practices to reduce nutrient runoff, support farmers, and provide important ecosystem benefits in the Ohio River Basin. Now, the resulting credits are available for purchase in the effort's first public auction. Backed by science, metrics, and state approvals, "stewardship credits" can be applied toward sustainability goals, offsetting supply chain impacts, and Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) obligations in Ohio, Indiana, and Kentucky.

- What does "verified credit" really mean?
