 - b. Share a new dairy craft or easy recipe that teachers could do with their students in class.
 - c. Holiday specific ideas that could go into newsletters that are around the holidays while still including dairy key messages and a take home piece for teachers
 - d. Highlight another dairy website with great teaching tips and tricks for dairy education
 - e. Imagine any other possibility that you can think of if you had the platform to talk to more than 11,000 elementary and middle school teachers at once.

4. Topics not to cover:

- a. Anything political or religious
- b. Negative topics against other branches of agriculture
- c. A story about yourself you can introduce yourself but there needs to be meat to the article that includes items under number 2.
