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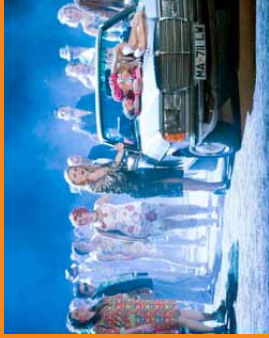

The King, thus sure of divine blessing for his cause, wages war on the French all too proud in overpowering strength. After the Battle of Agincourt, the French King has to yield his daughter as a peace offering. In a bitter satire, this political marriage is then portrayed as the happy ending joining the two recent lovers.

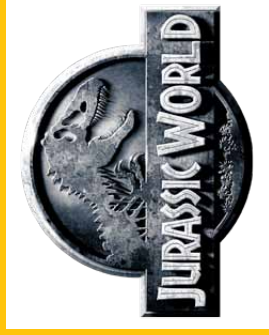
