For 29 years, founding Artistic Director Margaret Mehuys' version of Nutcracker captivated audiences with its powerful charm and magic; and was enjoyed by more than 200,000 spectators in Montréal, Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, Trois-Rivières, Granby, Hamilton and Costa Rica.

Ballet Ouest de Montréal is proud to perform its version of the beloved Nutcracker ballet, adapted and choreographed by Artistic Director Claude Caron in 2013. This ballet features lavish costumes, spectacular multi-media and an enthralling and enchanting tale to delight the entire family.

Nutcracker opens in Montreal at Centre Pierre Péladeau, Salle Pierre Mercure in early December with four matinée performances presented in front of Montreal-area schoolchildren, Nutcracker: Sharing the Magic, a benefit evening for local charitable organizations, and three public performances. The company will then continue their tour to Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu and l'Assomption, where similar casts of children will have been rehearsed throughout the Fall.
