The NWS in Louisville is now accepting applications for student volunteers for **Summer 2017**. Interested students are encouraged to apply!

Typical student volunteers assist with and complete various research projects and other assigned tasks. Students also will have the opportunity to learn about NWS forecast duties and operations. During severe weather, students will assist with social media, gather storm reports, etc. Students may also have the opportunity to participate in storm surveys and other familiarization trips across central Kentucky and south-central Indiana as time and resources allow.

Who: Undergraduate meteorology or atmospheric science students

How to Apply:

- Submit a 1-page resume
- Provide a 250 word (or less) statement answering:
 - o Why you are interested in volunteering for the NWS?
 - o What are your career goals following graduation?
 - What are your technical/computer skills?
- Unofficial copy of college transcript

Volunteer Program Details:

- Summer 2017 (Mid/Late May through Early/Mid August)
- Up to 8/hours per week
