## INSURANCE FOR CROWN CARS

- 1. This letter advises authorities of the current position on discussions with Treasury to secure agreement to authorities taking out third party insurance cover for the business use of Crown Cars.
- 2. In EL(89) P/109 (FPCL 126/89) authorities were advised that discussions were underway with Treasury on a variation to Government Accounting Rules to allow for authorities to take out third party insurance cover in respect of the business use of Crown Cars. These discussions have not yet been concluded and may not be for a matter of weeks. It is still hoped that the outcome will be positive and that the benefits outlined in para 4 of EL(89) P/109 (FPCL 126/89) can be realised.
- 3. It is understood that some authorities have not yet renewed the comprehensive private use cover under the Central Call Off Contract pending the outcome of the discussions with Treasury. This has caused some concern to Eagle Star, the current insurers, and Bain Clarkson the brokers and to the Department in case any staff will not have cover on 1 August.
- 4. In the Department's view the renewal of cover under the Call Off Contract remains in the best joint and long term interests of authorities who are urged to renew their cover under the Central Call Off Contract as soon as possible.
- 5. This letter may be cancelled on 1 August 1990.
