Setting up Single Serve Cocktails

Not every bar sells pre-packaged, single serve cocktails, but some of our users had questions regarding setting them up as Items. They also asked about including them in Sales Items that will be factored into Variance Reports and Pour Cost Reports. This include products from lines like **Smirnoff Ice** and **Bacardi Breezer**.

As you know, BarkeepApp comes automatically installed with a set of standard Items that are commonly used in most bars. Remember, you are not limited to the set of default Items. If you need to add single serve cocktails, you will find many when you [Search Barkeep's Database](#) of over 75,000 wine, beer and liquor products that can be found on our server. You can add as many Items as you need to your Items List. See your User Guide for detailed instructions for adding Items.

Which Category should you use?

BarkeepApp has a set of default Categories. You might select one of the default Categories such as **Well Liquor** or **Call Liquor**, but it would probably be best to create a new **Single Serve Cocktail** Category. Single serve cocktails in bottles and cans are typically sold in the same way you sell bottles of beer. Just like a Category **Bottled Beer**, creating one called **Single Serve Cocktail** is what we would recommend.

Or you could create a Category that matches how you classify single serve cocktails in your POS System.

Above is the Sales Item for the single serve cocktail **Breezer - Key Lime**. The Recipe has a Quantity of 1 Bottle. You would only use a quantity in ounces if the Sales Item used a partial amount of single serve cocktail, which is unlikely.
