GFRi external goal is to engage on greening financial regulation at 2 levels: international level with policy makers and international standard setters and national level with national central banks and financial supervisors.

Your tasks

The Junior GFRi officer is mainly responsible for supporting GFRi Lead, facilitating the work of GFRi secretariat and the engagement of GFRi members with Central Banks and Financial Regulators. Therefore, he/she

- develops and update useful tools for GFRi and its members,
- develops institutions (meetings, calls, etc.) that facilitate collaboration and alignment of the individual GFRi members,
- participates to content development with active contribution to GFRi secretariat and Workstreams (particularly the WS3 on tools and methodologies for Central banks to integrate environmental risks and impacts into their activities).
- Participates to the development of roadmap for central banks and financial supervisors to tackle deforestation.

His/her secondary responsibility is to support the internal and external Communication efforts of the GFRi.

Administrative Tasks:

- Participate to preparation of all GFRi Calls.
- Elaboration of relevant materials and documentations.
- Creation and update of useful tools for the GFRi members.
- Responsible of GFRi members "hotline" for GFRi tools and share Hub.
- Participation to the KPI monitoring and report writing.

Content development:

- Workstream participation: Junior GFRi Officer will actively participate to relevant GFRi WS to help develop useful content.
- Summaries of existing tools and methodologies.
- Participation to the creation of communication products for the initiative (slides, articles, reports publication etc...) and management of the internal and external GFRi website.

Events preparation:

Participation to the preparation of GFRi international events like physical meeting for GFRi members, regional workshops or webinars for CB&FS.
