## MEDICAL MISSION GRANT COLLABORATION

April 2025, The DAISY Foundation is excited to announce the expansion of its Medical Mission Grant Program through a collaboration with AMN Healthcare.

Launched in 2018, DAISY offers funding to DAISY Honorees who want to share their clinical expertise and extraordinary compassion with underserved populations around the world by serving in a medical mission. Applications are accepted and reviewed year-round by nurses with expertise in mission work, and recipients are notified quarterly. To date, over 80 Honorees have received grants to help offset the expenses of volunteering for a medical mission trip.

In addition to the DAISY Award® for Extraordinary Nurses, the Foundation expresses gratitude to the nursing profession internationally in over 7,000 healthcare facilities and schools of nursing with recognition programs for nurses wherever they practice, in whatever role they serve, and throughout their careers – from nursing student through lifetime achievement, and through several lines of research grant and evidence-based practice projects funding.
